

## Risk assessment (AVRA2)

### Course

Risk assessment forms a mandatory part of the Machinery Directive as well as being a requirement under the Management of Health and Safety at Work Act.

This training offers a detailed methodology of risk assessment. It will look at hazard identification and risk evaluation and methods for recording, reviewing and maintaining them. You will be supplied with a template for carrying out your own risk assessments. At the end of this course you will be able to carry out risk assessments of your equipment.
